SpongeBob Beanie

Updated August 6, 2020

YARN: Caron Simply Soft: Super Duper Yellow, White, Black, Chocolate and Blue Mint
I Love This Yarn Super Soft: Yellow, Brown, White (Use CSS colors for the eyes to add a bit more shine)

Red Heart Soft: Lemon, Chocolate, White, Black, Turquoise

HOOK: G or H Hook (depending on the thickness of the yarn and the tension in your stitches, you may need to adjust your hook size to get the right tension in your stitches.)

BEANIE

Follow the Magic Yarn Solid Beanie pattern in Yellow until last three rounds.

3rd to Last Round: Using White yarn, 1 HDC in each stitch.

2nd to Last Round: Using Brown yarn, 1 HDC in each stitch.

Last Round: Using Brown yarn, 1 SC in each stitch. Fasten off and weave in ends. Please ensure your adjustable loop is closed and end is woven in securely.

EYES

White Yarn:

R1: 8 SC in adjustable loop (8)

R2: 2 SC in each stitch around (16)

R3: *2 SC in the 1st stitch, 1 SC in the next stitch*, repeat from * to * (24)

R4: *2 SC in the 1st stitch, 1 SC each of next 2 stitches*, repeat from * to * (32)

R5: *2 SC in the 1st stitch, 1 SC each of next 3 stitches*, repeat from * to * (40)

Black Yarn:

R1: 8 SC in adjustable loop (8)

Attach Blue Yarn:

R2: 2 SC in each stitch around (16)

Leave long tail on both pieces for sewing

LASHES

- Use 2 strands of black
- Lashes are long stitches using black yarn, leave starting tail loose inside
- Hide yarn between lashes by going between the beanie and the eye to the next lash
- After 3rd lash, again go between the beanie and eye back to the loose tail and tie together
- Using a yarn needle, pull the ends back between the beanie and eye to hide

NOSE

R1: 8 SC in adjustable loop (8)

R2 – R3: 1 SC in each stitch (8)

Leave long tail for sewing
