



Yoda/Baby Yoda

Updated April 2021

Please only attempt if your Solid Beanies have been previously approved by Magic Yarn Leadership

YARN: Caron Simply Soft Pistacchio or Red Heart Soft Guacamole

HOOK: Same size as used for your approved MYP beanies, usually G or H

GAUGE: Measure the crown after row 8 (see solid beanie pattern).

BEANIE: MYP Solid Beanie using approved yarn (do not mix brands).

EARS (make 2): Start with a magic circle, ch 1.

Row 1: Sc 4 sts into the circle and pull on yarn to close.

You will be working in the round, place stitch marker here to keep track of rows)

Row 2: Sc in each st around (4).

Row 3: *2sc in next st, repeat from * around (8)

Row 4: Sc in each st around (8).

Row 5: *2sc in next st, sc in next st*, repeat from * around (12).

Row 6: Sc in each st around (12).

Row 7: *2sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts*, repeat from * around (15).

Row 8: Sc in each st around (15).

Row 9: *2sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts*, rep from * around (18).

Row 10: Sc in each st around (18).

Row 11: *2sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts*, rep from * around (21).

Row 12: Sc in each st around (21).

Row 13: *2sc in next st, sc in the next 6 sts*, rep from * around (24).

Row 14: Sc in each st around (24).

Row 15: *2sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts*, rep from * around (27).

Row 16: Sc in each st around (27).

Row 17: *2sc in next st, sc in the next 8 sts*, rep from * around (30).

Row 18: Sc in each st around (30).

Row 19: *2sc in next st, sc in the next 9 sts*, rep from * around (33).

Row 20: Sc in each st around (33).

Row 21: *2sc in next st, sc in the next 10 sts*, rep from * around (36).

Row 22-26: Sc in each st around (36).

Sl st in first st of last row and fasten off leaving a long tail.

Finished ear is 5 - 6 inches.



Fold the base of the ear down about an inch and sew it secure to stay in place. This will give the ear that fold-over look. Be sure to make the folds so that there is one left ear and one right ear



Once you've made two, sew on your ears to the sides of your hat with a blunt needle so that they are centered on the side of the beanie. Fasten off and weave in your ends.
